1. Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for transfer of the case titled as ‘Mehtar Singh and others Vs. Gram Panchayat Behlopur’ bearing NNo.118/VCL (Annexure P-1) instituted under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 from the Court of respondent No.3 to any other competent authority.
2. Keeping in view the averments made and the fact that on an earlier occasion, the Co-ordinate Bench vide order dated 31.01.2023 passed in **CWP-10669-2022** (Annexure P-2), had already issued directions regarding expeditious disposal of the case within a period three months. Thus, we do not feel that it is a fit case to exercise the extra-ordinary writ jurisdiction and stay the proceedings before respondent No.3. The matter has been pending adjudication since the year 2013 and apparently the averments regarding respondent No.3 have been made in this writ petition, merely on the basis of surmises and conjectures.
3. Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
