1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings invoking Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, alleging willful disobedience of order dated 21.03.2024 passed by this Court in CRM-M-14805-2024. The operative part thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide complaint dated 07.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

2. In response, compliance report by way of an affidavit of Mr. Deepak Pareek IPS, SSP, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 21.03.2024 passed in CRM-M-14805-2024, inquiry was conducted and DDR was registered under Section 427 IPC.
4. In view of the above, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.
