The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.142 dated 15.07.2023, registered under Sections 324, 336, 148, 149 of IPC, Sections 27, 30-54-59 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Dharmkot, Moga subsequently enhanced Section 326 IPC, Police Station Dharmkot vide General Diary No.20 dated 23.07.2023 and Sections 427, 447 IPC enhanced vide General Diary No.34 dated 23.07.2023, again enhanced Section 30 of Arms Act, 1959 vide General Diary No.13 dated 22.07.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.08.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.08.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
5. Pending application, if any, is also disposed of.
