Petitioner has filed instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.) for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner in FIR No.213 dated 25.06.2024 under Sections 149, 308, 323, 324, 326, 452, 458 and 506 IPC, 1860 (Section 326 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar, Haryana.
