1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 13(4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002 Act.

2. Learned counsel for respondent-Bank submits that order dated 12.11.2021 whereby notice of motion was issued with further direction that subject to petitioner's depositing a sum of Rs.4 lakhs with respondent-Bank within 6 weeks, no coercive action will be taken, was not complied with. Possession of property was taken by respondent-Bank and property has been successfully auctioned. Therefore, this writ petition is rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he does not have any instruction in this matter.
4. In view of given facts and circumstances, writ petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to petitioner to avail remedy/ies available to her in accordance with law for any subsisting grievance. Petitioner is also at liberty to file appropriate application within four weeks from today, in case any incorrect fact has been placed before us.
5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
