MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for quashing of the impugned order dated 18.01.2018 (P-3), passed by respondent No.1, whereby an application of respondent Nos.2 & 3, filed under Section 22 (2)(1) of the Senior Citizen Act, 2007, was allowed.

(2) Case called twice, but no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioner.



(3) On 15.10.2018 also, none came forward on behalf of the petitioner, resulting into dismissal of the main petition for want of prosecution; however, on an application, the same was restored vide order dated 26.10.2018.

(4) In view of the above, it seems that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present writ petition.

(5) As a result thereof, there is no option except to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

(6) Ordered accordingly.

(7) Needless to say that interim order dated 22.02.2018, extended from time to time, shall come to an end, automatically.
