Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 05.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the partition case bearing No.174-Partition dated 07.02.2023 titled as Parshant etc. Vs. Sukmani Devi etc. (Annexure P-1) has been transferred from the Court of Assistant Collector 2nd Grade Saraswati Nagar to the Court of Assistant Collector Ist Grade Jagadhri, wrongly illegally and even without notice to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition and a direction be issued to the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade Saraswati Nagar, Yamuna Nagar before whom the partition proceedings are pending to decide the same in a time bound manner.

In view of his prayer, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. Ld. Assistant Collector 2nd Grade Saraswati Nagar, Yamuna

Nagar is directed to conclude the partition proceedings expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order, if there is no legal impediment in the same, Ld. Collector will be free to take into consideration the stay order, if any, passed by any higher authority/Court of law in the present case.
