VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is the Civil Revision Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for setting aside the order dated 03.08.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Sr.Div.), Kanina, in Civil Suit no.CS 297-2020 titled as “Guljari Lal vs. Ram Chander and others”.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from Kamal Kaushik son of Guljari Lal plaintiff, has submitted that the petitioner would withdraw the present revision petition but only prays that it be clarified that the observations made in the impugned order be not treated as observation on the merits of the main case and the main case be decided independently, in accordance with law.



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- 3. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3 has submitted that he has no objection to the said aspect.
- 4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present revision petition.
- 5. It is made clear that the observations made in the impugned order would not be treated as binding with respect to the final adjudication on the merits of the case.
