1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.3 to decide the representations dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) and 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take strict legal action against respondent No.4 under the appropriate provisions of law.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, UT, Chandigarh to look into his representations dated 05.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) and 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. B.R. Rana, Advocate for Mr. J.S. Toor, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
