RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.06.2023 passed in CWP-13183-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dharminder Singh, Estate Officer, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated order dated 06.06.2023 passed in CWP-13183-2023 has since been complied with; grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and encroachment pointed out by him has since been removed. Accordingly, the present petition has become infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
