Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.463, dated 29.07.2024, under Sections 22(b) of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for brevity,`the NDPS Act`) and later on added Sections 29-61-85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Krishna Gate, Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 13.08.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 13.08.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jaipal, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 13.08.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands allowed.
