JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.121 dated 12.05.2021 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.09.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that Ramesh Kumar (wrongly mentioned as Rajiv Kumar in the order dated 22.11.2023) and Sushil Kumar both stand arrested and recoveries have been effected from them. He contends that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 19.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
