This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 6 to 9 for not harassing the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner, feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No.6 to 9 who happen to be his sons and grand sons and apprehending danger to his life, had moved the representation dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3 to consider and dispose of the representation

dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Japjot Singh, AAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 5 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala to consider and dispose of the representation dated 07.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and also to examine the aspect if the petitioner is having some threat to his life and liberty and take action accordingly.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of.
