This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), whereby, the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled and he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court on 21.08.2023, the petitioner surrendered and appeared before the trial Court and this very fact has been admitted by learned State counsel that the bail bonds has already been executed by the petitioner before the trial Court on 12.04.2024 and thus he is on bail.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant petition as the impugned order dated 17.03.2022 has become redundant and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
