The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* to quash the letters/orders dated 03.08.2024, Annexures P-3 and P-4, passed by respondents No.3 and 4, respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R. S. Budhwar, Additional A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before the respondents within a period of one week from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the second respondent-Director General, Higher Education Haryana, by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.
