Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C, prayer is made for quashing of the order dated 10.08.2007 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in case FIR No.79 dated 01.06.2000, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 452, 353, 186, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Banga, District Nawashahar.
