1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.80 dated 18.07.2024 under Sections 115(2), 127(2), 351(2), 316(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the following order dated 02.09.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency :

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjinder Singh, has submitted that there was due compliance of the order dated 27.08.2024 passed by this Court and the recovery of a passport was affected from the suitcase of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that recovery of some cash amount alongwith the gold ornaments is yet to be affected.

Adjourned to 25.11.2024.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the

investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of her arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. It has also been submitted that petitioner was declared innocent and therefore, her custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the above, the present anticipatory bail is allowed and interim order dated 02.09.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
