The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been preferred seeking grant of parole under the provisions of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner after having been convicted vide judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 25.01.2013 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri in case FIR No.381 dated 10.10.2008 registered under Sections 302, 341, 323, 148, 149 and 427 IPC had preferred the appeal vide CRA-D-414-DB of 2013, which however was dismissed on 05.05.2017. She submits that the petitioner had earlier been granted the concession of parole and after the expiry of period, the petitioner had surrendered back on 18.11.2023. Learned counsel for the petitioner



submits that on account of mother of the petitioner being suffering from Cancer, he has moved an application for grant of parole to respondent No.4 on 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) but till date no action thereon has been taken. She further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if directions are given to respondent No.4 to consider and dispose of his representation/application (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the documents on record and keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
