After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that some of the posts of Veterinary Officer as advertised vide Advertisement dated 03.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) are still lying vacant to be fulfilled from General Category, hence, the petitioners intend to make a representation to the respondent-State for consideration of their claim against the said vacant posts and the State be directed to consider the said claim by passing an appropriate speaking order.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will



be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file representation with the authorities concerned.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
