1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Samana vide which the application for amendment of written statement under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC has been dismissed.
