NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, claiming the following reliefs:-

" i. A writ in the nature of Certiorari for the quashing of impugned order dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-12) rejecting the claim of the petitioner for the grant of LTC payment of the petitioner for the block 2014-2017 as per the LTC bill raised dated 11.01.2018.

ii. A writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the LTC payment of the petitioner for the block 2014-17 as per the LTC bill raised dated 11.01.2018 (Annexure P-5) along with interest at the rate of 18% on account of delayed payment of the same."

2. The petitioner was accorded permission for LTC block year 2014-17 for travel from Amritsar to Goa from 09.12.2017 to 25.12.2017 along with the family. Admittedly, the petitioner has travelled from Chandigarh to Goa instead



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of Amritsar to Goa along with family and the air tickets have been attached along with the petition as Annexure P-4.

3. During the course of hearing, it has been agreed that the claim of the petitioner shall be reconsidered by the Competent Authority.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Competent Authority to re-consider the claim of the petitioner, as per the rules, and the admissible benefits shall be released to him, within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order.
