HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled for regularization of his services on the post of Chowkidar, which benefit has been given to the other staff including the staff nurses and therefore, as per the Notification dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), the claim of the petitioner should also be considered for regularization of his services, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is working for the last more than one decade.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been raised in the representation dated 03.05.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-8 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage if, a direction is issued to the

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respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner and shall decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Charan Preet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned State counsel submits that in case the representation dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the concerned office, an appropriate speaking order on the same would be passed by respondents within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to him.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
