HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

Present set of two writ petitions involve common question of law in the background of common set of facts and thus they are being decided by a common order.

In these petitions, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for regularisation of their services on the post of Chowkidar, which

benefits has been given to the other staff including the staff nurses and therefore, as per the Notification dated 08.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), the claim of the petitioners should also be considered for regularisation of their services, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are working for the last more than one decade.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance of the petitioners have already been raised in the representation dated 03.05.2024 in both the petitions, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-8 and the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage if direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same in the time bound manner and shall decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the representation (Annexure P-8) dated 03.05.2024 has been received in the concerned office, an appropriate speaking order on the same would be passed by respondents within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present set of petitions may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
