MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the official respondents to get the detainee released forthwith from the illegal custody of the private respondents.

2. In compliance of order dated 09.08.2024, report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh has been received in a sealed cover, which is opened and the report perused. The same is taken on record. The alleged detainee has made a statement on 13.08.2024 before the learned CJM showing her willingness to stay with her parents.

3. The alleged detainee is present in Court and has been duly identified by learned counsel for the private respondents. On a pointed query put to the alleged detainee, she has categorically refused to



accompany the petitioner and has rather reiterated her statement made before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh.

4. In the circumstances, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same stands dismissed.
