1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to re-fix the pension of the petitioners by granting them an annual increment for the service rendered by them in their last year of service i.e. retiring year as they have completed requisite 6 months or more than 6 months of service, with all consequential benefits of arrears etc. along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 20.07.2024 (Annexure P-12). He submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is decided by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.

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4. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, to decide legal notice dated 20.07.2024 (Annexure P-12) submitted by the petitioners, expeditiously by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
