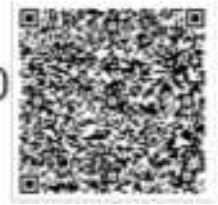

The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in a case bearing FIR No.16 dated 23.02.2024 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 447, 511, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Maloudh, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 19.08.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

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The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 14.08.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 14.08.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
