The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents to file status report in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 363/366-A of IPC registered against accused/respondent No.6 at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga.
