PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.50 dated 19.07.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 408, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC at Police Station Verka, Police Commissionerate Amritsar on the basis of compromise deed dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-7).
2. Counsels are *ad idem* that the matter has been compromised and out of the compromised amount, substantial amount stands paid.
3. Counsel for complainant further submits that he has no objection in case the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail.



4. Keeping in view the incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and the fact that the matter stands compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

5. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
