1. This common order of mine shall dispose of all the above-mentioned petitions as all are arising out of the same FIR. For the sake of brevity, the facts are borrowed from **CRM-M-37204-2019** titled as ***Satnam Singh versus State of Punjab and another.***

2. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.88 dated 30.06.2019 registered under Sections 420/177/494/120-B IPC at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Kumar, at the outset, submits that the investigation of the FIR (supra) was concluded and cancellation report was prepared, which has been filed before the jurisdictional Court and the same is pending consideration for 10.01.2025. As such, nothing survives in the present petitions.
4. In view of the specific statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petitions at this stage, however, he seeks liberty to file fresh petitions on the same cause of action, in case, any adverse order is passed by the jurisdictional Magistrate on consideration of the cancellation report.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
