The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioner under Old Pension Scheme (OPS), and release all the consequential benefits arising out of the past service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the third respondent. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the third respondent is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 09.05.2024, Annexure P-8, in a specified period.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the pending legal notice will be decided by the third respondent/Director General, Skill Development and Industrial Training, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
