1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. A further prayer has been made for calling a status report in a case FIR No.254 dated 13.12.2022 under Section 447 of IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana (Annexure P-6) as well as FIR No. 157 dated 26.08.2023 under Sections 323,427,448,34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana (Annexure P-7). A further prayer has been made to issue appropriate directions to implement the civil Court judgments (Annexures P-1,P-2,P-4 and P-8.)
2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of official respondents and on instructions from Insp. Jasvarinder Singh submits that final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been presented in a case FIR No.254 dated 13.12.2022 and FIR No. 157 dated 26.08.2023 before the competent Court of law. Learned

State counsel further submits that there is no imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. Still further, for execution of Civil Court judgments and decree, the petitioner may approach the concerned Court.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly, disposed of.
