This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the constitution of India for issuing writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner/convict for premature release in terms of the para 2 (b) of policy dated 13.08.2008 (Annexure P-2) as the petitioner has undergone more than 14 years of actual sentence and the petitioner is still deprived of the benefit of Premature release under Haryana Government Policy dated 13.08.2008 and the respondent didn't consider the case of the petitioner and didn't even paid a heed towards the application that was moved by the petitioner annexed as Annexure P-1 and that petitioner has become entitled to be released forthwith on usual terms and conditions on the basis of the policy and that her further detention has become violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits



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that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the application dated 14.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) within a time bound manner.

3. Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondent No.3- The Superintendent, Central Jail-1, Hisar is directed to consider and decide the application dated 14.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) keeping in view the policy as is applicable to the case of the petitioner for premature release, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
