1. Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C, prayer is made for issuance of direction to the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, to conclude the trial within a stipulated period, in case FIR No.130 dated 30.05.2021, registered under Section 25/59 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions, imparted to him by ASI Baljit Singh, informs this Court that after conclusion of the investigation in the FIR (supra), the final report has been filed on 13.07.2022, and the charges have been framed on 11.10.2023. Learned State counsel further submits that out of the total 10 prosecution witnesses cited in the final report, only 02 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far.
3. From the above facts, it is clear that the trial is progressing in the right direction, and at a good pace, therefore, no further direction is required to be made, to time bound the conclusion of the trial, however, a direction is passed

upon the learned trial Court concerned, to make all the efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously.
