This is an appeal filed by the appellant. However, respondent No.3 - Insurance Company has also filed cross-objections.

On 09.01.2024, on behalf of the appellant statement was made to accept ₹30,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹30,000/- (₹ Thirty Thousand Only) is allowed to the appellant against the Insurance Company.

Accordingly, we dispose of this appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹30,000/- in the name of the appellant - Gaurav son of Shri Karnail Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 26.02.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The

appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the cross-objector/respondent No.3 - Insurance Company that in view of compromise in main appeal i.e. FAO No.5737 of 2015 filed by the appellant and as per instructions from Mr.Amit Vyas, Legal Manager, Shri Ram General Insurance Company Limited, he does not want to proceed further with the cross-objections and that the same be dismissed as withdrawn. His statement to this effect has been recorded separately.

Cross-objections stands dismissed as withdrawn accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
