The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0268, dated 29.11.2020, under Section 420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Palwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police-City, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

The matter pertains to the year 2021 and notice of motion was issued on 15.11.2021 since then, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner to address the arguments till date.

On the same time, learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 17.05.2022 passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur and the anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 04.07.2022 by this Court in CRM-M-26222-2022.

In the light of above, it is evident that the petitioner is not interested in further pursuing the instant petition and the same is dismissed for non-prosecution.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed off.
