1. This is an application for placing on record the additional affidavit.
2. Allowed as prayed for. Additional affidavit of Rakesh Sandhu, Deputy Secretary to Government Haryana, Secondary Education Department, Haryana, is taken on record.

COCP-5-2021

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.02.2019 passed in CWP-13160-2016.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Anshaj Singh, Director Secondary Education, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 06.05.2016 has since been re-visited and fresh order has been passed. In the

fresh order, five petitioners have been found eligible and entitled to the promotion and they have been actually promoted. However, one of the petitioners has not been found entitled to the promotion. Therefore, his case has been rejected. Copy of the order dated 15.04.2024, produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
