1. By way of present petition filed under Section 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged non-compliance of order dated 12.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-19056-2018. The operative part thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed. Let the process of medical reimbursement qua the medical bills submitted by the petitioner be completed within a period of three months from date of receipt of copy of this order.”

2. In response, learned counsel representing the respondents submits that a pay order dated 22.08.2024 has been prepared in the name of

the petitioner for a sum of Rs.3,78,170/- and the same shall be credited to his account within a period of one week from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel representing the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file representation with the respondents as regards any balance towards medical reimbursement, which shall be decided by the respondents within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such application.

4. Disposed of accordingly. Rule discharged.
