MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of Khalistani leaders and supports as the petitioner is constantly receiving threats from anti-social organisations.

2. In compliance of order dated 14.08.2024, short reply by way of affidavit of Lakhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. Learned State counsel, at the outset, has drawn the attention of this Court to the averments made in paragraph 3 of the aforementioned affidavit. It has been submitted by learned State counsel that the petitioner had indeed been receiving threats from



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unidentified persons claiming themselves to be members of a terrorist's outfit. Hence, in order to avoid any untoward incident and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, appropriate orders had been issued to provide him with security in accordance with rules and procedures.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner prays that the instant petition be, therefore, disposed of in view of the averments made in the affidavit filed by the State.

5. Disposed of as such.
