The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.63 dated 22.04.2024 under Sections 420,406,467,468,120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 20.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
