NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the punishment order dated 06.01.2016 (Annexure P-3), whereby it was ordered to impose 5% cut in the pension of the petitioner for a period of 02 years.
2. In the written statement filed by respondent Nos.2 to 6, it has been stated that against the said punishment order, the petitioner has preferred an appeal which was partly accepted by the Appellate Committee and the punishment of 5% cut in pension for 02 years was reduced to 5% cut in pension for 01 year vide order dated 16.02.2018.
3. The effect of the said punishment is already over in the year 2019 and the same was not challenged either, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
