1. In the present petitions, the claim of the petitioners is that they are entitled for minimum of the pay scale as granted vide Instructions dated 03.11.2017 but the respondents are not granting the said benefit and that too without any valid justification.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 20.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the legal notice dated 20.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reason will be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.
