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VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant 5 marks to the petitioner under the socio-economic criteria for having no job in her family.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that in continuation of the final result, the petitioner has been selected and a corrigendum regarding the same has been issued on 31.01.2024, a copy of which has been handed over to the Court during the course of arguments and is taken on record as Mark-A, and in pursuance of the same, the petitioner would be granted appointment as expeditiously as possible. It is further

submitted that in view the same, present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid stand, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such but the respondent-Authority be made time bound to issue the appointment letter to the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and the respondent-Authority is directed to issue the appointment letter to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 3 months from today and subject to the petitioner fulfilling the other requirements, in accordance with law.
