1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working in the Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab and once, a particular benefit of the grant of Dynamic Assured Carrier Progression Scheme has been allowed in the favour of Medical Officers working in the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, the petitioners are also entitled for the same, who are working in the Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab so as to avoid any disparity especially when the State in one of the litigation has conceded the fact that the Medical Officers working in the Department of Rural Development and Panchayats Punjab, are entitled for the same benefit as being given to the Medical Officers working in the Department of Health

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and Family Welfare, Punjab hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioners the benefit of Dynamic Assured Carrier Progression Scheme.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners in the representation dated 30.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Charan Preet Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 30.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may



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kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
