The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.460 dated 26.12.2023 under Sections 307, 427, 34 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Section 25 of Arms Act has been deleted later on) registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-3).

2. This Court vide order dated 14.08.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mohindergarh and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has



submitted report dated 17.09.2024 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence. Statements of the complainant and other eye witnesses /victims who were not impleaded as parties were also recorded and have been annexed with the report.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.460 dated 26.12.2023 under Sections 307, 427, 34 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Section 25 of Arms Act has been deleted later on) registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) are quashed qua the petitioners.
