1. By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which

have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions

involve the same question of law on similar facts.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide order dated 12.10.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the respondent-State was directed to decide the representation dated 25.02.2014 (Annexure P-5).

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners had submitted the said representation was never received by the Department and the learned counsel for the petitioners agreed to file a fresh representation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already filed a fresh representation with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners in terms of the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court on 12.10.2022, appropriate speaking order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order if not already passed and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
