The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.63 dated
29.06.2024 under Sections 406/498-A of IPC registered at N.R.I. Police
Station, Ludhiana along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case only for the reason that they are parents of the husband of the complainant. After the marriage of the complainant with the son of the petitioners, they were happily residing at the matrimonial home. The couple was sent to Canada on 16.01.2024 at the expenses of the petitioners. Thereafter, the complainant has levelled false allegations against her husband regarding illicit relations and harassment while in Canada. There was no dispute and complaint regarding harassment while the couple was staying in India and after causing altercation with the son of the petitioners in Canada by the complainant, the FIR (*supra*) was registered. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case all the pleas taken

in the present petition are considered by the Investigating Officer before submitting a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion.

On receipt of advance notice, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and submits that he has no objection in case, the Investigating Officer is directed to consider all the pleas which are taken in the present petition before preparing a final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer to consider all the pleas which are taken in the present petition before preparing a final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that in case the final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. is filed against the petitioners, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh petition to challenge the FIR as well as the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
