AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Power of Attorney on behalf of appellant has been filed by Mr. Inderjeet Sharma, Advocate and same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 29.07.2024, on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellant, a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.5,00,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.4,75,000/- and not by Rs.5,00,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellant has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.4,75,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) favouring appellant-Sagar s/o Sh. Madan Lal Baksi, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.09.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till

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cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
