The petitioner, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 13.05.2019 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 12520 of 2019.

[2] The main case stood listed for hearing on 03.10.2024.

[3] Now, by way of application bearing CM No. 14640-CII of 2024 moved on behalf of the applicant-petitioner, prayer has been made for disposal of the main petition being rendered infructuous as per compliance order dated 04.04.2024 annexed with the application as Annexure A-2.

[4] Notice of the application.

[5] Mr. Arun Beniwal, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and submits that the amount due towards the petitioner shall be released within a period of two weeks from today.

[6] In view of the above, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner does not press the main petition and prays for taking up the same today itself, to which, learned counsel for the respondent raises no objection.

[7] With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the main case is preponed from 03.10.2024 and is taken up today itself.

[8] In view of the aforesaid development as well as contents of the application bearing CM No. 14640-CII of 2024, duly supported by an affidavit of the petitioner, the same is allowed and the main case is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

[9] Rule stands discharged.
