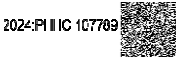

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the letter dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) vide which petitioner has been intimated by respondent No.2 that total recovery of Rs.3,56,464/- w.e.f. 01.08.2012 to 31.08.2021 is to be made out of the pension on account of wrong fixation of pension. Further prayer has been made for direction to the respondents to stop the recovery of Rs.6,000/- being made from the pension of the petitioner after about 19 years of his retirement and to refund the recovery already made from the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-4).

He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said



legal notice is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

- 4. Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
- 5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
- 6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition, respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 27.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- 7. The petition stands disposed of.
