MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.53 dated 23.06.2023 under Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 and enhanced Sections 392, 473, 411 of the IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions, has vehemently opposed the prayer made for extending the concession of bail to the petitioner in the instant case. It has been submitted that the petitioner was nabbed by the police on suspicion; thereafter recovery of a country-made pistol was effected. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner is a native of Chhatisgarh and was on bail in the other FIRs, which had been registered under Section 394 IPC at Police Station Madhuban, when he was apprehended by the police on suspicion. He has

further submitted that it is thus apparent that the petitioner had misused the concession of bail which had been granted to him by the Court at Chhatisgarh. It has also been submitted that charges have not yet been framed and are likely to be framed on the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court i.e. 12.02.2024.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material on record.

4. Prima facie, there are serious allegations leveled against the petitioner, more so, he has misused the concession of bail which had been granted to him by the Court at Chhatisgarh. In the facts and circumstances, as enumerated hereinabove, this Court does not deem it fit to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petition as such is dismissed. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
